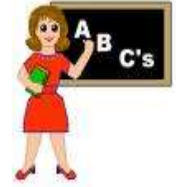
The Software Strategies Program assists with meeting the needs of a variety of students to enhance reading and writing skills. Students are taught how to use and integrate programs such as Kidspiration, Inspiration, SpeakQ, WordQ, ReadPlease, Kurzweil, and Microsoft Word as well as other document processing software. Space is limited due to the low student-teacher ratio. Students enrolled in this program will be able to purchase some of the software at a discounted price.

The program will be offered in 5 hour increments. Each 5 hours of the program will be incorporated into the student's program schedule. A maximum of 25 hours of Software Strategies is available over 5 weeks

LANGUAGE WORKSHOP:

This course is suitable for students entering grade 7-10 in September 2011

An introduction to the grade 10 Literacy test will be incorporated into the reading and writing segments of this workshop.

The focus will incorporate a variety of English language skills including the writing, reading and study skills so necessary for the success of Middle and High School students. The following skills will be addressed each week and are great tools for across the curriculum.

WRITING:

•journalistic •expository •creative writing •parts of speech •spelling •proofreading •paragraphing •editing
•sentence structure •writing process (i.e. outlines, multiple drafts, revision) • grammatical structure / properties / rules

READING:

•fluency •selected literary pieces •reading comprehension •vocabulary building •inferential meaning awareness
•personal reflection

STUDY SKILLS:

•test-taking strategies •summarizing •outlining •key information extrapolation •organization skills
•note-taking •hi-lighting •question analysis •library use •proofreading •following directions

MATHEMATICS WORKSHOP

This course is suitable for students entering grade 7-10 in September 2011

The focus will incorporate a variety of mathematics skills that corresponds with the Ontario Curriculum. The following skills will be addressed each week and will help students be prepared for the following school year.

Number Sense and Numeration: •quantity relationships (i.e. fractions, integers, exponents) •operational sense (i.e. multiplication, division, subtraction, addition)

Geometry and Spatial Sense: •geometric properties (i.e. calculating angles using various tools) •geometric relationships (i.e. distinguishing between similar and congruent shapes) •location and movement (i.e. Cartesian coordinate plane, transformations)

Measurement: •real-life applications •units of measurement •calculation of two and three dimensional objects

Patterning and Algebra: •patterns and relationships •variables, expressions, and equations

Data Management and Probability : •collection and organization of data •data relationships (i.e. reading, interpreting, and drawing conclusions from primary and secondary data) •probability

E.S.L. E.S.L. can be incorporated into the programs using creative learning activities to improve the student's ability to communicate in the English language. Fluency is built by applying structures and functions of English in meaningful, practical situations. **The four basic language skills will be emphasized: speaking, listening, reading, and writing.**

Students will be assessed and placed into the appropriate program level.

REFUND POLICIES

WILLOWWOOD SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

The administration reserves the right to cancel enrolment of a child if deemed in the best interest of the child and / or program. Should this be necessary, the remaining tuition fee will be refunded less a \$200 cancellation fee.

1. If the withdrawal occurs prior to acceptance, \$50 application fee will be retained
2. If withdrawal occurs after acceptance, but before June 15th, \$250 will be retained.
3. If withdrawal occurs June 15th-26th, 50% of the fee will be retained.
4. After June 26th, ALL FEES will be retained no refunds will be made.
5. Withdrawal requests must be submitted in writing only.
6. Days absent, for any reason, cannot be considered for refund: however, in case of illness of two (2) consecutive weeks or more duration, a 50% refund of balance of program fee will be made. A Doctor's certificate is required in the above situation.

HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS

Refunds, less a \$100 administrative fee per application will be issued for all course cancellations up to 5 business days prior to the first day of classes of a course. Refunds are not available after that time. Refunds for medical reasons (prorated) are available upon the submission of a doctor's certificate, up to the end of the summer session. Refunds are not available for days absent, courses dropped or not completed. – see High School information package

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Programs operate on weekdays only
- Applications completed in full and accompanied by the appropriate deposit will be considered for acceptance
- Deposit of \$350 must accompany the application for all programs except high school credits

DISCOVER LEARNING WORKSHOPS PROGRESS REPORTS

- These are completed for students and are sent out at the end of August.

LOCATION

- Programs are located on the premises of WillowWood School at 55 Scarsdale Rd.

DATES

- Summer Programs begin July 4th and run through August 5th for a total of 5 weeks.
- Students may attend any number of weeks for Exciting Adventures in Learning, Language Workshop, Mathematics Workshop. The weeks do not have to run consecutively, but may be split up over the summer.
- Software Strategies can be incorporated as an addition to our other programs or may be enrolled in as a 1 week full 25 hour program (see information & application).
